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Passover Food Drive March 17-April 1

The Community Passover Food Drive, a joint effort of 11 local Jewish organizations, takes place March 17 through April 1 at several area collection sites, including the Milwaukee Jewish Federation and the Harry and Rose Samson Family Jewish Community Center. A complete list of collection sites is available at MilwaukeeJewish.org.

Products needed, which must have kosher certification for Passover: matzo, gefilte fish (cans preferred), chicken soup/matzo ball mix and grape juice. These basic items will then be supplemented with additional traditional Passover items.

In 2013, Passover food items or grocery store gift cards were given to over 700 individuals and families.
