No Boycott at the Riverwest Public Hours

August 27, 2013

Last night, the board of the Riverwest Public House Cooperative voted to table the issue of boycotting Israel. Mindful that such requests distract the co-op from its mission, the nine-member board voted to form an internal committee to develop a policy regarding responding to requests on international/political issues.

History: As you may know, the co-op was approached with a request to support an economic and cultural boycott of Israel. Because it was the first such request of its kind in the co-op's short history, the board invited the requesting organization – the Milwaukee Palestine Solidarity Coalition (MPSC) – to present at a "public speaking event" on July 31. At that event, which drew about 35 people, MPSC representatives presented a distorted survey of the conflict, followed by questions and comments from both sides. About 15 pro-Israel community members attended that event, effectively communicating to the co-op the strong opposition to a boycott. Afterward, many members of our community wrote letters to the co-op, reinforcing that any boycott would be divisive and may have negative consequences for the co-op.

Last night, the board approached this issue thoughtfully and carefully – and chose not to support a boycott of Israel. Two anti-boycott community members spoke at the meeting, one from the JCRC board and the other is a co-op member. Special thanks to them and to all who showed up at the public speaking event, wrote letters and shared concerns with the co-op. I encourage you to visit and support the co-op, and consider joining as a member/owner.

We will continue to follow this issue at the co-op and other possible targets for boycott.
