I have a theatre called: "Happy with Hagar". It is a small theatre with a broad repertoire of one-man shows.

I give presentations and conduct workshops in Israel and in other countries about my work as a medical clown in hospital in trauma zone.

I work at Tel Hashomer Hospital in pediatric radiation and surgery units and at Barzily Hospital in pediatric and neo natal units. In addition, during the years I have specialized in working with anxiety and post-traumatic patients at Bazily Hospital during the missiles attacks on the south of Israel.
