


ON ROSH HASHANA WE

OF THE JEWISH NEW YEAR.




WE DIP APPLES IN HONEY  
FOR A SWEET NEW YEAR.




WE EAT ROUND CHALLAH.

WE CELEBRATE YOM KIPPUR.




YOM KIPPUR IS A TIME TO SAY

I'M SORRY...




ON YOM KIPPUR NIGHT WE GO TO

DAY.




AFTER YOM KIPPUR COMES  
SUKKOT.




WE BUILD A SUKKAH FOR SUKKOT.







IT'S FUN TO DECORATE THE  
SUKKAH.




DURING SUKKOT, WE EAT IN THE SUKKAH.
