

# Fortune Teller: Colors in Hebrew

Cut out the large square. Use Avery dot labels to designate the colors, placing them where indicated by tiny arrows. (Option: Color the circles with markers.) Fold the square to make a "Fortune Teller."

## "How to play:

Player one is the "Counter" and will be operating the "Fortune Teller. Player two is the "Color Caller." After Color Caller picks a number, Counter counts in Hebrew or English while moving the "Fortune Teller." Of the four colors visible, Color Caller selects one and must give the Hebrew name for the color. When player are more advanced or for extra points, colors may be spelled in Hebrew as well. Counter then lifts the flap to check for the correct answer.

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
