Let's Celebrate the Fall Holidays

Directions for assembly:

1. Color all pages using watercolor markers or colored pencils.
2. Laminate or cover the pages with clear contact paper (optional).
3. Using a razor or X-Acto knife, cut out windows and slits on pages 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 16, 17 and 18.
4. Cut small pieces of magnetic tape and attach where specified on pages 3, 5 and 13.
5. Cut out the manipulative pieces for the book. Page numbers next to the pieces are the page numbers on which they belong. Specific directions for attaching some of the pieces are also given.
6. Assemble as follows:

Page 1: Fold the tab part of the calendar toward itself and then open the tab and pull it through the slit on the book page. The tab will be on the back of the page. Then tape the tab in place on the back of the page.

Page 2: Put a brad (brass paper fastener) through the black dot on the shirt cuff and then through the dot on the book page. Spread the brad apart in back to fasten.

Page 3: Slip the challah slice tab through the challah as directed for page 1. Attach the magnetic tape to the back of the other challah slice. It will now stick to the magnetic tape on the challah.

Page 4: Slip the envelope piece with the tab through the envelope following the same procedure as before. Fold the large envelope on the dotted lines. Glue the bottom and two side flaps together to form an envelope. The triangular top flap should **not** be glued down. The New Year's card should be folded on the dotted line with the writing facing out. The card should then be inserted in the envelope. The back of the envelope can then be glued to the book page on the appropriate spot. Either contact cement or double-sided scotch tape can be used.

Page 5: Put a small piece of magnetic tape on the back of the shofar. It can now be attached to the book page in either of two locations.

Page 6: Insert the calendar piece as directed for page 1.
