Memorial Service

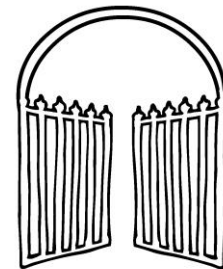
Sunday, October 9, 10:00 am at Ft. Howard Cemetery
