

## Marcus and Rita Wohlfeiler Memorial Scholarship Fund

The Jewish Community Foundation of Milwaukee Jewish Federation is pleased to announce the opening of the Marcus and Rita Wohlfeiler Memorial Scholarship Fund, a new endowment fund that will support college scholarships for deserving high school students who need assistance with furthering their education. Preference will be given to students who are immigrants themselves, or children of immigrants who have fled countries in turmoil. Marcus Wohlfeiler was a Holocaust survivor whose family was greatly aided by the Jewish communities in Milwaukee when they immigrated to Wisconsin after World War II. This fund was established in a spirit of gratitude to the Milwaukee Jewish community, and to provide aid for future students as they begin their first year at a U.S. college or university.

### How to Apply

The application process is open for students beginning their college freshman year in the Fall semester. Applications and accompanying documents and materials for the Fall semester must be received by March of that year.

Applicants for scholarships from the Harry Hecht Family Memorial College Scholarship Fund are automatically also considered for scholarships from the Evelyn & Ben Breitman Education Endowment Fund.

### Eligibility

- Applicants must apply during their *senior year of high school*. If applicants delay college, they should apply in March of the calendar year they will begin college. Awards for winners will be directed to their college/university to be applied to tuition for their freshman year of college.
- Applicants must be in the process of applying or accepted to a full-time, accredited undergraduate program in the U.S.
- Applicants must be residents of the Milwaukee metropolitan area.
